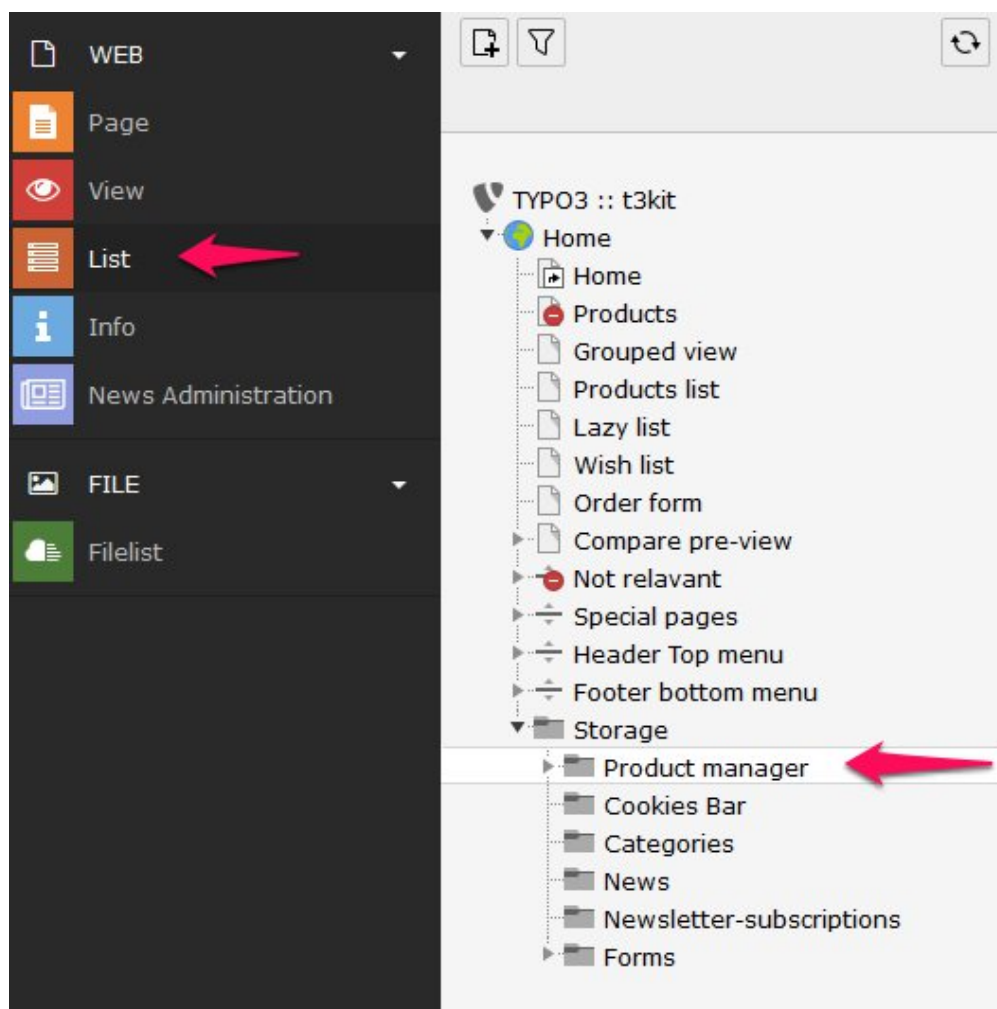


# Exporting data through List view

This tutorial will show you how to export data from your TYPO3, using the List view functions.

Select 'List' view in the control panel, and the page which you wish to export the data from. In this example we will be exporting product data from the products folder.



Exporting data from List view

## Selecting fields to export

Before exporting the data, we need to select which type of

records and fields to export from the folder. As we are exporting product information, we will start by limiting our view to products. Do this by clicking the header section of the products.

Selecting data for export



The product list view will now be updated, adding each field type as a column.



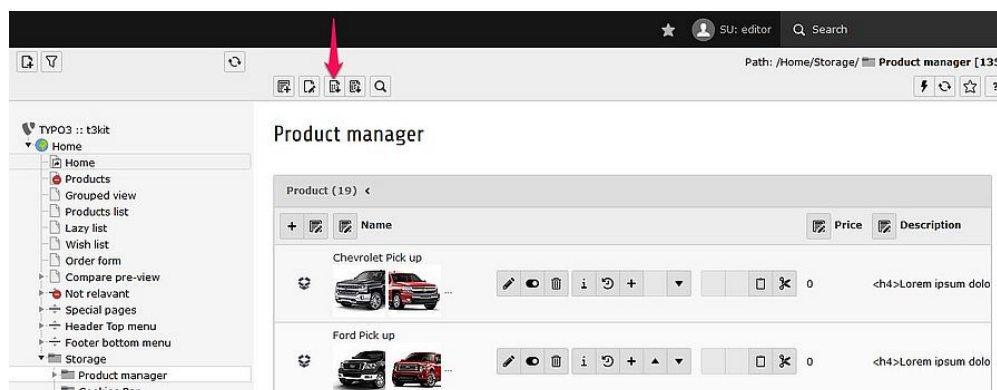

To export the desired data, click the export icon above the product listing.

A file will now have been saved on your computer.
