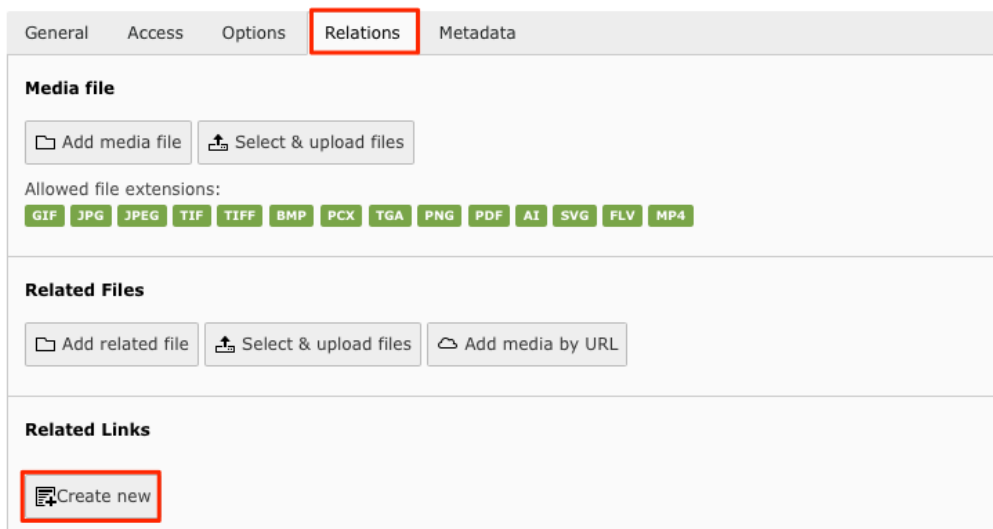


2.7 Add links to news article

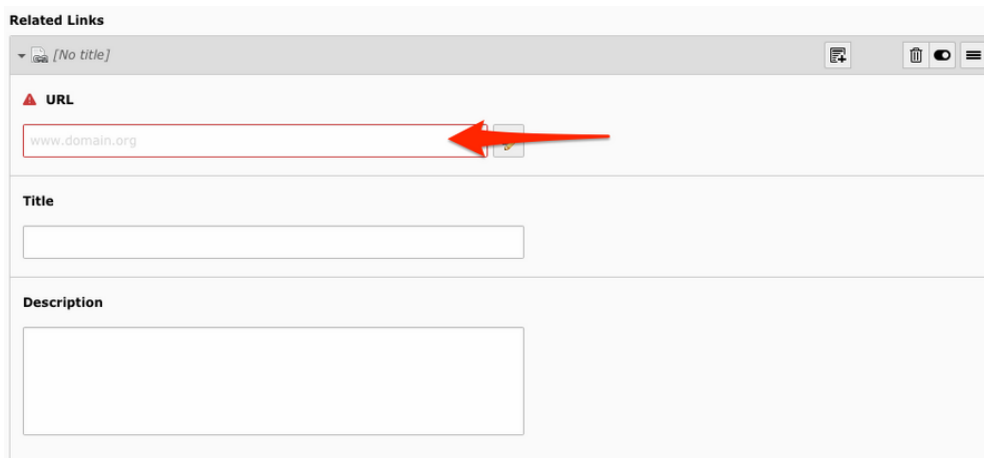
You can add links that will appear below the news article. Go to the 'Relations' tab and below the section 'Related links' click 'Create new'. (img. 2.7.1)
