


2.3 Slider container

To create a 'Slider container' go to a 'Grid Elements' tab. (2.3.1)

Grid Elements

- Two columns grid**
Preset row with two columns.
- Three columns grid**
Preset row with three columns.
- Four columns grid**
Preset row with four columns.
- Advanced one column grid**
Advanced grid. Preset row with one column. Column width can be adjusted.
- Advanced two columns grid**
Advanced grid. Preset row with two columns. Column width can be adjusted.
- Advanced three columns grid**
Advanced grid. Preset row with three columns. Column width can be adjusted.
- Advanced four columns grid**
Advanced grid. Preset row with four columns. Column width can be adjusted.
- Collapsible**
A collapsible container for content elements
- Group of collapsibles**
A group for collapsible elements
- Parallax**
Background image with Parallax effect
- Simple Accordion**
Container with collapsible child elements, which can either be single elements or containers as well
- Slider container**
Slider container for content elements
- Group of tabs**
A container for tab content elements

In the 'General' tab, you can see that the content element type 'Grid Element' (1) and grid layout 'Slider container' are selected (2).

The element also uses the regular header field (3) and a link field (4), where you can insert the site or page you want to link to. (2.3.2)

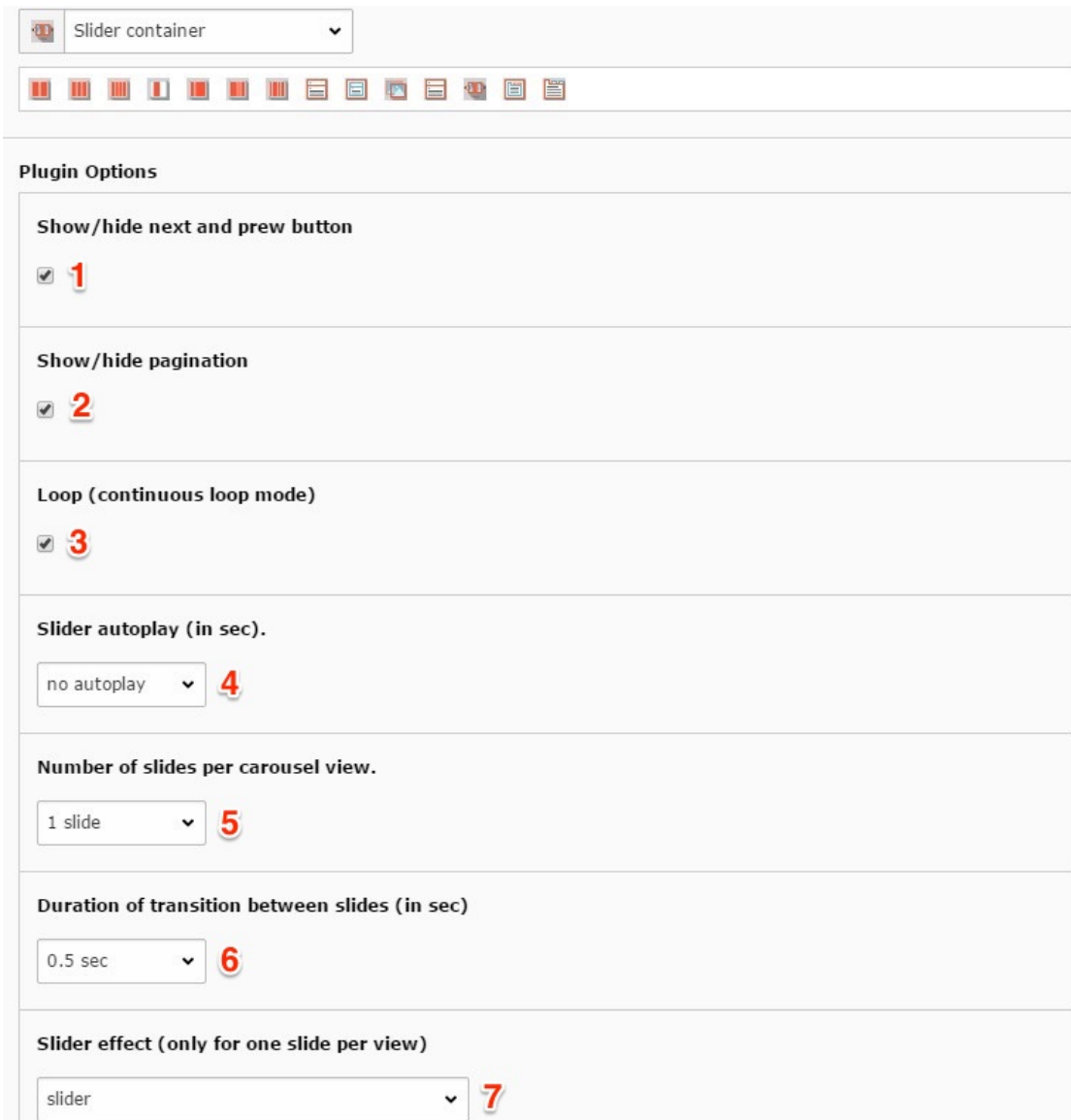

The 'Slider container' has multiple settings to fill your needs. You can decide if the buttons, to see next or previous slide, should be visible (1) and if there should be a pagination (2). You can also set if the slides should be in a loop (3) when autoplay is set (4). If you have smaller elements in the slider container, you can select to show more than one in each slide (5). You are able to set the transition time between each slide (6). Finally, if you have one slide per carousel view set, you can also add slider effects (7).
