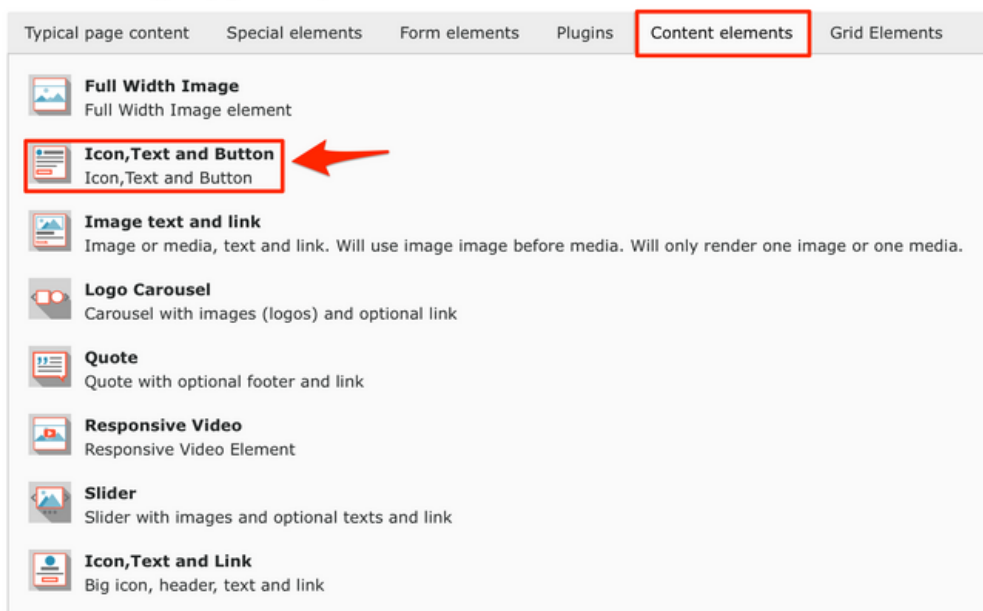


5.5.2 Icon, Text and Button

The "Icon, Text and Button" element is an info box, that is often used on the start page or as a promo box in a right hand column on subpages. You can find the element below the tab Content elements when creating a new element. (img. 5.5.2.1)



In the 'General' tab you can see the content element type 'Icon, Text and Button' selected (1).

The element uses the regular header field (2) and a text field (3), which is a plain text field, and it is not possible to format this text with row breaks, linked text or any type of text transformation. (img 5.5.2.2)
