


## 1.4 Icon, Text and Button

The 'Icon, Text and Button' element is an info box, that is often used on the start page or as a promo box in a right hand column on subpages.

You can find the element below the tab Content elements when creating a new element. (1.4.1)

A button with twbs style
-  **Bootstrap Slider**  
Basic slider included from Bootstrap package. Add sliding interval and turn on/off quickselect.

Slider with images and optional texts and link

Quote with optional footer and link
-  **Logo Carousel**  
Carousel with images (logos) and optional link
-  **Responsive Video**  
Responsive Video Element
-  **Full Width Image**  
Full Width Image element
