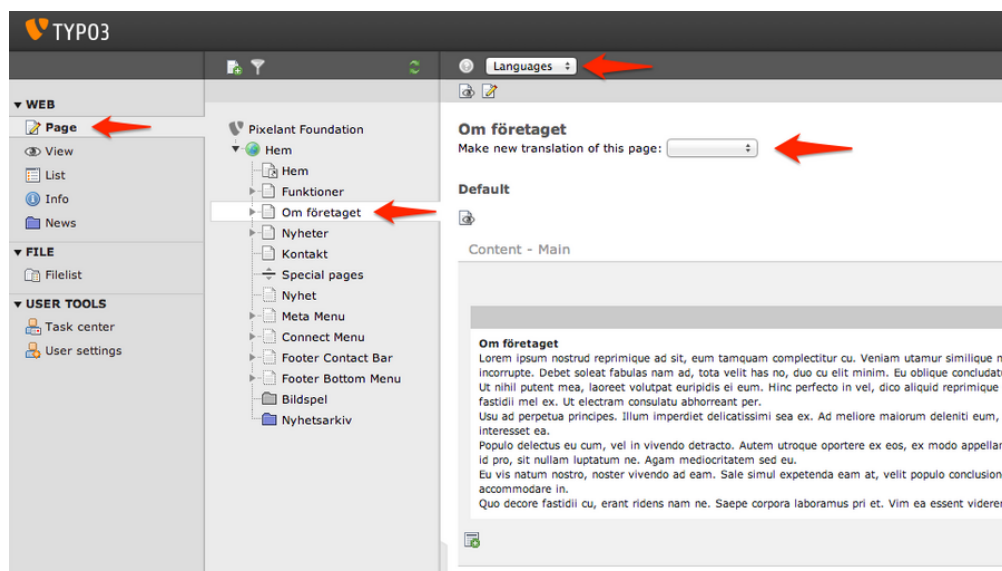


1.1 Create translation

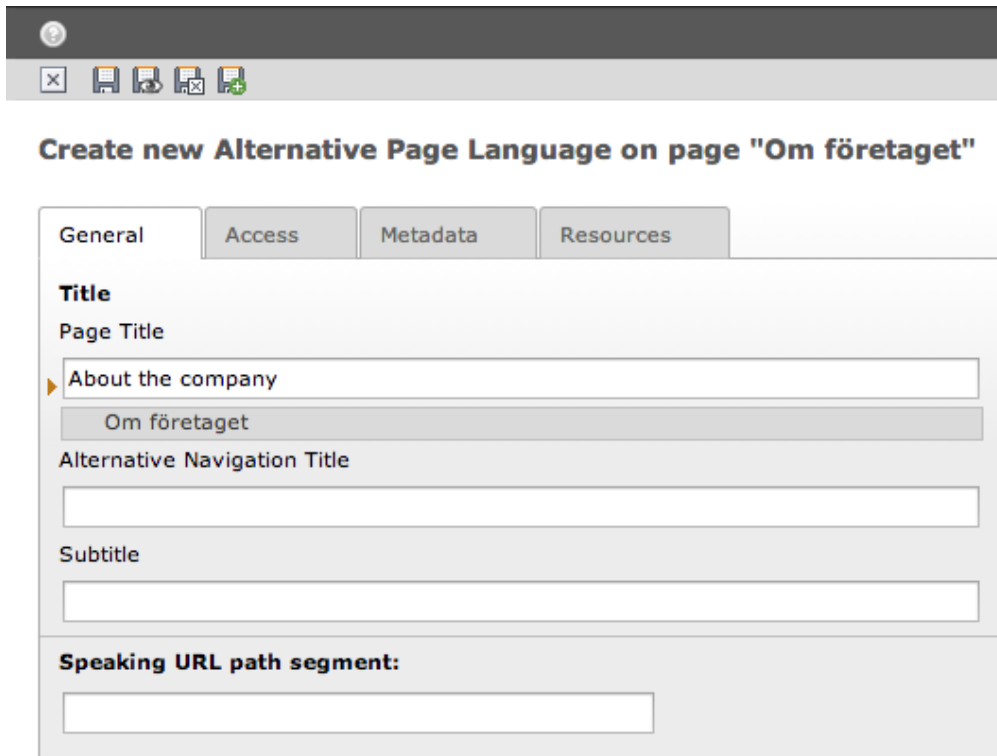
This section explains how to create a translation from default page. If you need to create a page only shown in specific language, see chapter 5.

Select Page in the left hand menu and then the page you wish to translate in the page tree. Set drop down above work field to "Languages" and finally select a language in the drop down menu further down to create translation. (img. 1.1.1)

Fill out the page title, then save and close, unless you wish to add meta data or hide the page translation if the language is live. In this case continue to next sections before saving. (img. 1.1.2)
