


5.1 Set translation to single language (not default)

This function is used to create a page that should only be visible for a language other than the default language.

Create a standard page and name according to what it should be for the translated language (so that you can locate it easier in the page tree). In the page properties for the default language, below the tab 'Behaviour', check the box 'Hide default translation of page' before saving and closing. (img. 5.1.1)
