

Editing footer content is very individual depending on the website. The two most common locations are as regular page content at the bottom of the start page or it can be found in a folder in the page tree.

On some websites there are more information in the footer, ex footer links. These can almost always be found as pages in the page tree, below a page containing the word "footer".

We will here show you how to edit footer content through the FrontEnd editing or through the footer content located in a folder in the page tree.
