














1.2 Image, Text and Link

The "Image, Text and Link" element is also an info box, that is often used on the start page or as a promo box in a right hand column on subpages. The element can be found below 'Content elements' when creating a new element. (1.2.1)

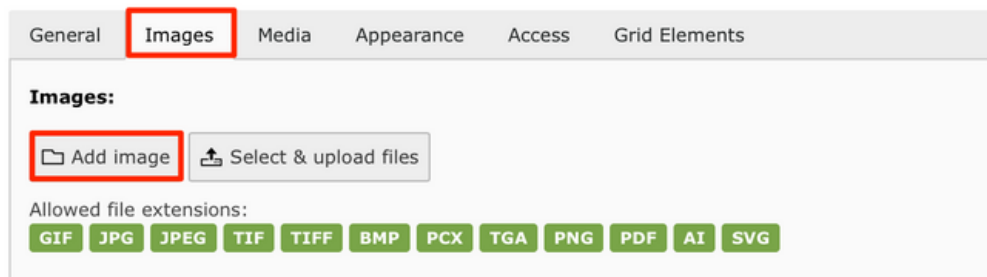



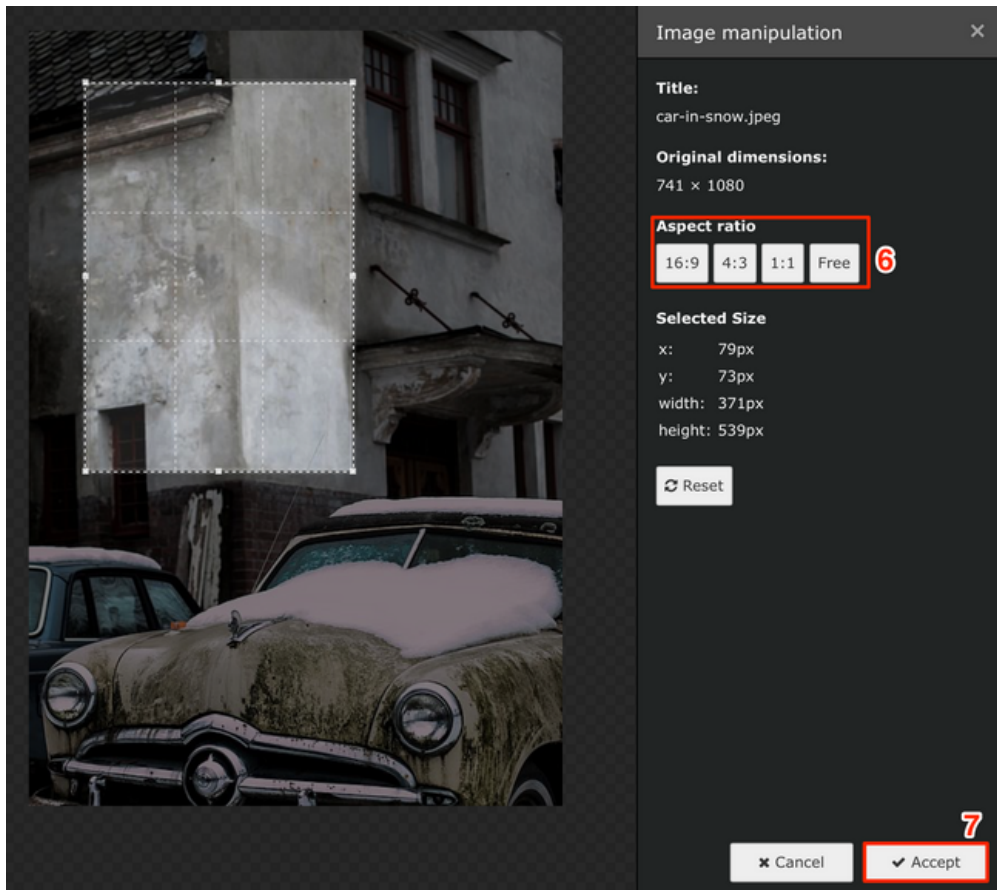
